Chairperson's report October 2017

Well more announcements around the world with more countries moving towards banning internal combustion engines and adopting electric drive. Most notably has been China with planning to implement quotas soon, and ultimately a complete ban. This has led to many manufacturers scrambling to pick up the pace with electric models.

There has also been announcement of particular cities planning to ban internal combustion engines from city centres.

The shift is on.

Hopefully this will lead to more models available here in Australia. Also it is hoped there will be some policy movement from the Federal Government to assist with EV adoption.

New charging hub.

It is great to see the new charging hub in Franklin Street. I was amazed how quickly it was installed. It is interesting how it can all happen with the right will.

We now essentially have a Tesla super charging network to Melbourne. Although they are for Tesla only, let us hope others are installed to cater for other brands. As seems to be the case Tesla is leading the charge.

Committee meeting 11th October 2017.

1. Just to confirm that Blake Spearman has replaced Chris Hickey on the Committee and taken on the role as Librarian.

I wish to formally thank Chris for his membership on the Committee, in particular ensuring our publications were available at our meeting and managing the loans and returns. 3. Christmas / end of year event. Over the last few years we had combined this event with a public EV display. Given that we do have displays at a number of events, it was decided to have a more relaxed event. It will focus on a members' day, more social. So Oaklands Wetland Saturday the 9th of December, 9 am to 4 pm.

4. Everergi ARENA grant application. Still no conformation either way regards the grant, I spoke to Daniel the CEO, who said they should know later this week. Also thank you to everyone that participated in the Everergi survey and provided feedback. There was a plan to have a follow up phone call, but the feedback was so detailed, there was no need to call. So thanks for those participating it has been of great assistance in testing and refining the survey questions.

External groups.

The groups considering an EV conversation enterprise are making good headway. More detail to come.

The group promoting the Formula E for Adelaide are still working to get it over the line. We should know soon, either way.

There was a possibility of AEVA sponsoring Wiebe from Plug Me In, to do a presentation (without his car) at the AGM in Tassie next month. Unfortunately he is
